

Set up a Personal Hotspot

On an iPhone



On the device that you want to connect to, go to Settings > Cellular > Personal Hotspot or Settings > Personal Hotspot and make sure that it's on. Then verify the Wi-Fi password and name of the phone. Stay on this screen until you've connected your other device to the Wi-Fi network.

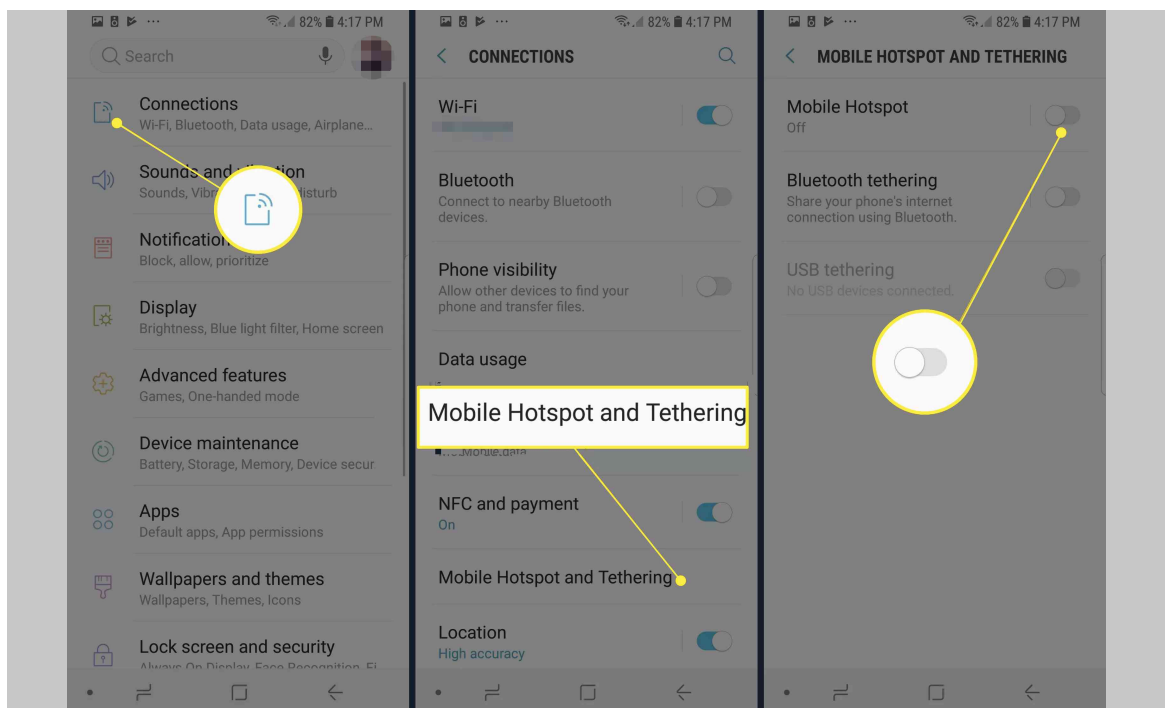
On the device that you want to connect, go to Settings > Wi-Fi and look for your iPhone or iPad in the list. Then tap the Wi-Fi network to join. If asked, enter the password for your Personal Hotspot.

On a Samsung Smartphone

On the latest Galaxy devices, including the [Samsung Galaxy S21, S21+ and S21 Ultra 5G](#) smartphones, turning on the mobile hotspot feature is as simple as pulling down your Quick Panel and tapping Mobile Hotspot. On some earlier Galaxy devices, you may need to open Settings and tap into the Connections menu.

To turn on the Wi-Fi hotspot, follow these steps:

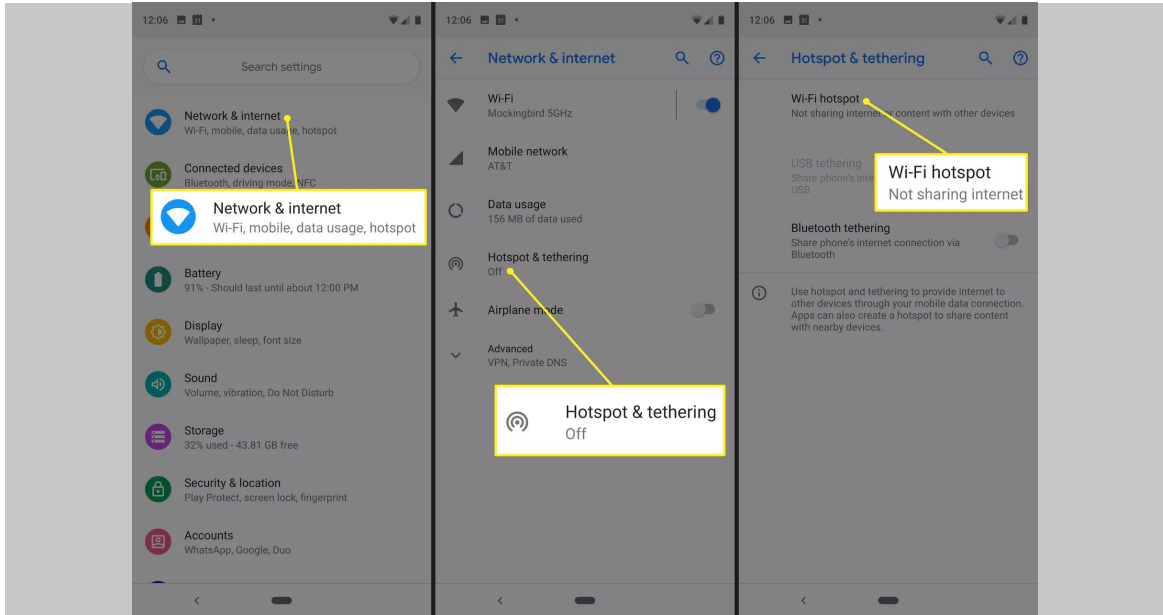
1. Go to **Settings > Wireless & networks**. On a Samsung phone, tap **Connections > Mobile Hotspot and Tethering**.
2. Turn on the **Mobile Hotspot** toggle switch. The phone becomes a wireless access point and displays a message in the notification bar when it's activated.



3. To find the password and instructions for the hotspot, tap **Mobile Hotspot**. Use this password to connect your other devices to the hotspot, just as you would connect them to any other Wi-Fi network..

On a Pixel or stock Android Smartphone

1. Go to **Settings > Network & Internet**.
2. Tap **Hotspot & tethering > Wi-Fi hotspot**.



3. Turn on the **Wi-Fi hotspot** toggle switch.
